

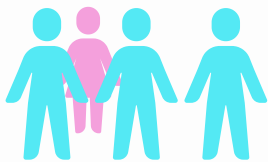
# FEMALE INEQUALITY

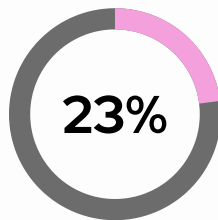
