Highlights of ACF's Powerful Social Impact in 2023!



Supporting Turkey's Earthquake Victims

AngelLink partnered with FL businessman, Onur Haytac, and [2L Foundation](#) to raise \$222,828 for the earthquake victims in Turkey. Special thanks to Colliers Reserve Community for their \$95,000 donation. All funds benefitted [Ahabap.org](#), the most trusted foundation in Turkey, providing immediate relief and long-term support to those affected by the devastating earthquake.



Helping Israeli Victims of War

Camille and Richard Forman generously partnered with AngelLink providing nearly \$40,000 in matching funds to benefit [United Hatzalah](#) humanitarian relief services in Israel. A total of \$85,269 was raised for emergency medical supplies and equipment for those wounded by the conflict in Israel and Gaza.



Climbing New Heights

George Kappaz and his two sons, Michael and Patrick, embarked on an expedition to Nepal to climb a Mt. Everest summit at 20,000ft. The father son team raised \$32,628 with ACF to support a small, grassroots charity called WECANHELP serving impoverished communities in Venezuela where George grew up.



Smart Fit Girls: Equitable Access to Movement

A nonprofit called [Smart Fit Girls](#) raised \$10,131 and surpassed their goal to fund scholarships for girls to participate in their health and wellness programs. ACF provided a \$1,000 matching grant to further support Smart Fit Girls scholarship programs.



Randy and Friends Helping the Underserved

North Georgia nonprofit [Randy and Friends](#), partnered with ACF to raise funds to support Midland ice cream shop that employs eight adults with disabilities. The team raised \$2,232 to buy a mobile ice cream cart to expand their services and enable more disabled adults increased independence and greater access to their community - paving the way to future accessibility and inclusion in the workforce.



Bullpen Way Pet Station & Sanctuary

The [Bullpen Way Pet Station & Sanctuary](#), (BWPS), located in the rolling hills of Northeast Georgia, raised over \$650 to expand their on-property breed shelters and rescue facilities. Since 2014, Bullpen has rescued over 1,000 dogs and has provided a safe space for at-risk pups with 15 climate-controlled pet villas. Providing a sanctuary for abused and abandoned pets, BWPS was able to further their animal welfare programs to save more of our four-legged friends.

Be a Big Wig!

In honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, [EBeauty Community](#) partnered with ACF to raise funds to deliver 5,000 recycled hand-made wigs to female cancer patients free of charge. The EBeauty team cleans and styles each wig to give to cancer survivors who may not otherwise be able to afford one. EBeauty empowers women undergoing cancer treatment with the gifts of dignity, care and love. You can't put a price tag on that.



Wasil Daoud: Tiktoker Helping the Homeless

ACF partnered with social media influencer, Wasil Daoud, to raise funds to support his efforts to feed the homeless in New York city. As part of his fundraiser campaign, the Angelink PR team was able to secure press coverage for Wasil's good work in Business Insider and Insider.com.



KissFM Changing Lives

Life can be hard – especially for kids. With increased mental health problems affecting more children and adolescents across the country, depression and anxiety cases have doubled among youth over the past few years. Suicide has now become the second leading cause of death for kids ages 10-14. KissFM stepped up to help by raising \$1,000 with ACF to support [Samaritan Center's](#) expansion of mental health services for children in Texas.



iHeartRadio WOAI: Serving our Veterans

After Col Kyle Carpenter survived a devastating explosion while serving in the Marines in Afghanistan, he spent two years recovering at Walter Reed Military Hospital in Washington, DC. During his time at the hospital, his parents stayed nearby at [Fisher House](#), a network of homes to support veterans and their families. iHeartRadio WOAI raised \$1,000 to support Fisher House's vital work with lodging, food, and other services for military families during periods of illness and recovery.



Comfort Crew

iHeartRadio KVET raised \$1,000 with ACF to support [Comfort Crew for Military Kids \(CCMK\)](#), a national non-profit organization whose mission is to deliver resources to help military kids and their families. ACF and iHeartRadio 98.1 KVET helped to fund 125 Comfort Kits that included a teddy bear, booklet on strategies to facilitate coping, a caregiver guidebook and animated videos to let kids know they aren't alone.



KASE 101 iHeartRadio Helping Rescue Animals

KASE 101 iHeartRadio partnered with [PAWS Shelter of Central Texas](#) to raise funds to support companion animals and animal rescue operations. KASE101 met their \$500 goal to support German Shepherd, Dewey, and Percy a Domestic Shorthair kitty, who were both in need of life-saving surgery. Through funds raised with ACF, both Dewey and Percy got their surgeries and found fur-ever homes!



Nationwide Community Give Back



In partnership with Angelink, ACF created a Nationwide Community Give Back program with LIVE activations in New York, Colorado, California and Florida to celebrate the power of giving on **National Be An Angel Day** by giving away free meals!

Angelink Founder & CEO, Gerry Poirier, was with the Heavenly Biscuit on Wheels giving free breakfasts to hurricane victims and recovery workers in Fort Myers, FL. Angelink's Director of Customer Ops, Francisco Manalo was at White Rice in San Diego, CA celebrating unity and generosity by feeding the people who make a difference there. The team also traveled to Denver, Co and Brooklyn, NY to share the love and expand the "Angel Give Back" community.
